From Castleberry ISD **Castleberry ISD is Currently Pre-Registering Students for Free, Full Day Pre-K and Kindergarten**

full day pre-kindergarten (pre-k) and kindergarten for the 2022-2023 school year. Pre-registration for the district's pre-k and kindergarten programs is happening online now.

Parents must finalize the registration process beginning Monday, May 2 to ensure their child is registered for the 2022-2023 school year.

Children enrolling in pre-k must be 4 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2022. Castleberry ISD's free pre-kindergarten program is available to all children, whether they live within the district boundaries or not.

Even if your child does not meet the federal qualifying guidelines for a pre-k program, he or she can still attend pre-k in Castleberry ISD. For more information about pre-k at Castleberry ISD, visit the district's Pre-K Enrollment web page.

Children enrolling in kindergarten must be 5 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2022. Incoming kindergarten students who live within district boundaries or reside outside

Castleberry ISD will continue to offer the district, but did not attend pre-k at Castleberry ISD need to pre-register online as soon as possible.

Students who are currently attending Castleberry ISD for pre-k do not need to pre-register. Parents must finalize the registration process beginning Monday, May 2, 2022 to ensure their child is registered for the 2022-2023 school year. Students who live outside the district may apply for an Out of District Transfer during pre-registration to be considered for the program. Registration for all other students attending Castleberry ISD for the 2022-2023 school year opens on Monday, May 2.



The borders of the United States have expanded considerably since independence was declared. As the nation grew, and more newer detailed maps were needed so the country could plan ahead and utilize the landscape and resources available. Gen. William Emory, an army cartographer, was a vital part of this process.

Emory's diligent studies and attention to detail not only shaped the borders of the United States but also shaped the bor-

When war erupted against Mexico in 1846, he was assigned to join Col. Stephen Kearney in his trek from Kansas to New Mexico and then to California to strip the lightly populated and almost undefended area away from Mexico. The mission was a tremendous success, and the northern third of Mexico was in American hand in a matter of months. Along the way, Emory continued to make careful surveys and notes of the regions the army marched through. In the course of the war, Mexican troops never again entered Texas. When the war was won in 1848, the Texas border at the Rio Grande was unquestioned, thanks to Emory's maps.

His efforts would reap huge dividends again in 1853 when the United States finalized the Gadsden Purchase from Mexico. The United States had won what is now the southwestern quarter of the country as a result of the Treaty of Guadalupe-Hidalgo in 1848. Mexico surrendered the lands from the Rio Grande in central New Mexico (what was then West Texas) across to California and the Pacific.

Because of Emory's surveys, federal officials realized some of the unique features of the area. Just south of the Gila River was a break in the Rocky Mountains, an area where the land was relatively smooth. The area was ideal for railroad construction as the concept and ultimate route of the transcontinental railroad began to be dis-




It's that time of year again! Springtime in Texas means lovely fields showing off the Texas state flower!
